5. ACCREDITATION

Accreditations can be collected at the TIC on Saturday 11th of June from 17:00 and during the official training. Team Leaders must provide a valid travel document for all athletes.*

Accreditations must be worn all the time properly around the neck. People without accreditation will not be able to access the competition venue. In case of the loss of accreditation please notify the TIC.

*Travel document will be used to check NAME, SURNAME, and DOB as per ABAF regulations.

6. COMPETITION

Running and Jumping events and Javelin Throw will take place on the Track of Topolica Stadium, other throwing events will take place above the Stadium on the designated field.

A. TECHNICAL MEETING

Technical meeting WILL NOT BE STAGED.

Team leaders should use the form “Questions for the Technical Delegate” which can be picked up at the TIC to ask questions.

Those forms should be submitted at the TIC by the end of the Official training on Saturday 11th of June.

FINAL CONFIRMATION AND WITHDRAWALS – Upon arrival at the Stadium, each Team should pick up their Entry List at the TIC. All changes (withdrawals, athletes missing from the list) must be submitted at the TIC no later than Saturday at 20:00.

The competition will be conducted in accordance with WA Competition and Technical Rules and ABAF Regulations.

B. TIC

TIC is located at the competition venue next to the stadium Coffee bar and athlete dressing rooms.

TIC working hours:

Saturday, 11th June

17:00 h – 20:30 h

Sunday, 12th June

8:00 h – 20:00 h

Procedures at the TIC:

- Distribution of Technical information
- Submission of personal implements
- Submission of Relay Confirmation Form (NO LATTER THAN 1 hour before the start of the event)
- Submission of the Appeal to the Jury of Appeal
- Return of the confiscated items and personal implements
- Communication with the Teams

C. CALL ROOM

Call Room is located near the finish line.

All athletes must report to the Call Room prior to the events according to the Call Room Timetable.

If an athlete participates in more than one event simultaneously, they must mention that to the officials in the Call Room.

In the Call Room officials will check athletes' BAGS, CLOTHING, SHOES, and BIBs.

CLOTHING – all athletes must wear official Team Vests.

SHOES – athletes' shoes will be checked – heel/sole, spikes, and model.

If officials notice that the shoe is not complying with Rule 5 of WA Technical Rules such shoes may be confiscated and sent to the WA for further inspection.

All items not complying with WA Competition and Technical Rules will be confiscated and returned to athletes after the event at the TIC.

Athletes will not be allowed to exit the call room with the following items: personal implements, mobile phones, video recorders, radios, CDs, radio transmitters, or similar devices.

Please note that chalk is not allowed for marking the runway or throwing circle and that may be confiscated by officials.

All athletes will be escorted to the field of play by an official.
No athlete can leave the call room on their own.

Athletes will leave the call room as per Call Room Timetable.

D. OFFICIAL TRAINING

Official training will be organized on Saturday (11th June) from 18:00 – 20:00.

Official training with starters will be organized from 18:30 – 19:30 on the same day.

E. WARM-UP AREA

The warm-up area is located on the training field next to the track (synthetic grass).

Athletes participating in Horizontal Jumps, 100m, and Hurdle races must report to the Call room at the designated time and they will first be escorted to The Back straight for warm-up, and after that to the Field of play.

F. RESULTS

For all track events, results will be measured by the FinishLynx system. FinishLynx False start system will be in place as well.

Jumping events and Shot Put will be measured by certified measuring tapes.

For other throwing events, results will be measured by EDM.

G. JUMPING EVENTS

TRIPLE JUMP TAKE-OFF BOARD: 9 m and 11 m for women and 11m and 13 m for Men

HIGH JUMP HEIGHTS (proposition)

Women: 1.50, 1.55, 1.60, 1.64, 1.68, 1.72, 1,76, 1.79 + 3 cm

Men: 1.80, 1.85, 1.90, 1.94, 1.98, 2.01 + 3cm

The Heights will be published officially after the end of the official training!!!

H. PERSONAL IMPLEMENTS

Personal implements must be submitted at the TIC no later than Saturday 11th June at 20:00 h.

I. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

Protest and Appeals will be processed in accordance with Rule 8 of WA Technical Rules.

Protests during the competitions shall be made by athletes or their representative orally to the Referee no later than 30 min after the publishing of the results.

The Appeal must be submitted in written form to the Jury of Appeal through the TIC no later than 30 min after the decision of the Referee upon a protest. Appeal must be written in the English language.

When submitting the appeal, a deposit of 80 € must be paid. If the decision of the Jury of Appeal is in the favour of the athlete/team deposit will be returned.

J. BIBs

BIBs will be given to the Team Officials at the TIC during the official training.

Athletes will receive and they must wear 2 BIBs - on the back and the chest except in jumping events where the athlete may wear one BIB on the back or the chest.

For Relay events, all athletes must wear their BIB on the back and Country Code BIB on the chest. Country Code BIBs will also be distributed at the TIC.

K. OTHER PROCEDURES

STARTER'S COMMANDS will be given in English.

All coaches can watch the events in the stands and through the fence of the stadium.

Triple jump coaches will have a dedicated area and must report to the Call room non later than the time for the athlete's Call Room exit time.

Each athlete can have only ONE coach in these dedicated areas.

7. MEDICAL

During official training and during competition, medical services will be provided at the competition site.

All athletes compete under the responsibility of the Federations that entered them.
